Jump Height Cards: All dogs entered MUST be measured by the judge before their first run except those with AKC jump height cards. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running if necessary. If your dog is measured into a taller jump height class, he must be moved up into it at the trial. If your dog is measured down, he cannot be moved into a lower jump class.
